

Cascade Locks Park

The Cascade Locks Park bridges urban places with green spaces. As Akron's urban park, it not only provides green space for residents and workers in downtown, the Cascade Locks Park also is the gateway into a regional network of trails, parks and greenways.

Explore the Cascade Locks Park and follow the Ohio & Erie Canal Towpath Trail to find:

- 33 miles of completed Towpath Trail through Cascade Valley Metro Park, the Cuyahoga Valley National Park and up to Cleveland Metroparks. Ultimately, the Towpath will extend 110 miles from Cleveland's Canal Basin Park near Lake Erie, south to Dover and New Philadelphia in Tuscarawas County.
- Connector trails that link from the Towpath Trail to other park areas with amazing hikes, rides and views of the Cuyahoga Valley.
- Historic Sites along the Trail that educate on our city and region's rich history.
- Places like the Mustill Store, Canal Visitor Center and the Boston Store that have been preserved to recall our past and educate for our future.
- Thriving wildlife including herons, beavers, turtles and birds as well as buckeye trees, wildflowers, beech trees and more.
- Views and access to the Little Cuyahoga River and the Cuyahoga River.
- The Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad running nearly parallel to the Towpath Trail. Ride your bike one way on the Trail and return on the Railroad for only \$2!
- Places to stop for refreshments or meals along your journey and places to picnic.
- A respite, to enjoy green space, nature and the quiet sound of water flowing through the Canal and the Rivers.
