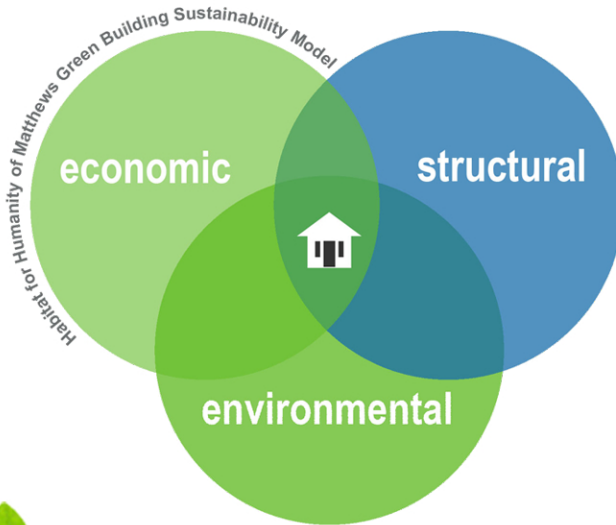




HABITAT MATTHEWS GOES GREEN

- A durable, low-maintenance environment
- A healthy home with improved air quality
- A high-quality, advanced, environmentally responsible home
