

HISTORY 1957-2008

North Central Sight Services, Inc., formerly known as the Lycoming County Association for the Blind, was incorporated



on February 7, 1957 as the 29th branch of the Pennsylvania Association for the Blind. The agency began operations at 901 Memorial Avenue in Williamsport.

The Lycoming County Association for the Blind manufactured rubber door mats from recycled automobile tires, caned chairs and performed subcontract work for local businesses. Support and talking book machines were provided to Lycoming County residents who were blind.

In 1974, the agency received funding to expand its Social Services. In 1982, Leroy Price retired as Executive Director. His successor, David Franklin established the Prevention of Blindness Department.

Robert Garrett was appointed as Executive Director in 1986. The service




region expanded to Clinton and Sullivan Counties and the agency name was changed to North Central Sight Services, Inc. in 1988. Over the next few years,

our service region further expanded to the Northern Tier counties and the industry operations grew and prospered. After fifty years at 901 Memorial Avenue in Williamsport, North Central Sight Services, Inc. moved to a new home at 2121 Reach Road in January of 2007. The 63,000 square foot facility is well positioned to meet our continued growth.



Going forward, we will continue to focus on the needs of people who are experiencing vision loss, creating employment opportunities for people who are blind and educating the public about eye health and eye safety.

We currently provide Social Services and Prevention of Blindness programs to eight counties in North Central Pennsylvania. The counties include Bradford, Centre, Clinton, Lycoming, Potter, Sullivan, Susquehanna, and Tioga.



PREVENTION OF BLINDNESS

Over 50 percent of blindness is preventable. Our goal at North Central Sight Services, Inc. is to promote public awareness about potential blinding eye diseases, prevention measures and the overall importance of eye health. We provide educational presentations and



information about eye safety and eye health for all age groups. Our child and adult vision screenings are designed to detect

symptoms of decreased vision which may lead to serious eye diseases.

If an individual shows signs of a visual problem and does not pass our screening, we refer that individual to an eye care professional for an exam.



Our Prevention of Blindness and Social Services programs are funded in part through grants from the Pennsylvania Bureau of Blindness and Visual Services, the Office of Vocational Rehabilitation and donations from the Harry Plankenhorn Foundation, Lions Clubs of 14G, and the Lycoming and Clinton County United Way.

FUNCTIONAL VISION CLINIC

Our Functional Vision Clinic provides financially eligible children an opportunity to receive a complete eye examination by a pediatric optometry specialist. Eyesight is the basic ability to see; vision is the ability to identify, interpret, and comprehend what is seen.



A child's eyesight may test normal with standard testing, yet visual skills may be seriously impaired. The qualified staff at the clinic understands and recognizes functional vision problems.

REMEDIAL EYE CARE

Our Remedial Eye Care Program is designed to assist low income individuals in obtaining eye exams and glasses. Through contracts with local eye care providers, a pair of eyeglasses and/or an eye exam can be provided at a reduced cost to those in need that qualify.

Applications are available in our office Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. We are located at 2121 Reach Road in Williamsport.

SOCIAL SERVICES

Our social service department provides a comprehensive program of activities and programs designed to help individuals who are blind or are experiencing vision loss. Our goal is to provide individualized services to keep people living as independently as possible. Once an initial intake is performed to assess an individual's needs and eligibility, our caseworker completes a service plan with the customer with clearly defined objectives and goals.



Our services range from one-time appointments to biweekly meetings. We also offer transportation and escort to doctor's appointments or grocery shopping when other resources are unavailable. Our qualified Casework Associates can assist with reading mail and bill-paying.

INFORMATION AND REFERRAL

Our goal is to provide services and education to individuals to help them stay independent. If we do not provide a specific service that a customer needs, we will refer him or her to an agency that can accommodate the need.

REHABILITATION THERAPY

Our Vision Rehabilitation Therapist provides individualized instruction in independent living skills to blind and visually impaired individuals.





Specialized instruction includes, but is not limited to the following:

- Kitchen safety/food preparation
- Communication skills (Braille, large print, audio)
- Home management activities
- Personal care and hygiene
- Lighting adaptations
- Low vision aids

Our Vision Rehabilitation Therapist will complete an assessment with the customer and develop an Individualized Service Plan. The Vision Rehabilitation Therapist will establish goals with the customer and work with him/her to achieve the desired goals.

LOW VISION STORE

Our Low Vision Store has many products that can help individuals who are blind or visually impaired become more independent. We have a wide range of products such as magnifiers, bold line paper, 20/20 pens, talking watches, large button phones, adaptive aids for cooking, large playing cards, and much more.

GROUPS

North Central Sight Services facilitates a number of support and educational groups to promote independence and life skills for people who are blind or visually impaired.

Life Skills and Education

This group offers valuable information on blindness-related topics facilitated by our Vision Rehabilitation Therapist with occasional guest speakers.

Book Club

Book Club members independently listen to a selected book, which is then discussed at a monthly meeting.

VISION Group

Participants attend social activities such as picnics, bowling nights, and holiday parties.

Ladies Club

Members participate in a number of activities such as large print bingo, trivia games and various holiday parties and picnics.



Craft Class

Our Vision Rehabilitation Therapist creates and adapts funcraft activities to accommodate those with vision loss. Our goal is to find ways for our customers to continue to do the activities they've always enjoyed.

Insight with a Bite

While sharing a good meal at various local restaurants, participants share how vision loss has affected their lives. This group is full of support, encouragement and fun.



Exercise Your Mind

Participant challenge their mental "strength" through various trivia games.


SPECIAL EVENTS

North Central Sight Services hosts special events for our customers and the community. Yearly events include the holiday Plankenhorn Party which is sponsored by the Harry Plankenhorn Foundation. We also coordinate groups for the Tour of Lights on the Williamsport Historic Trolley during the holiday season. One of the premier events in the spring is the annual fishing trip.



LOW VISION REHABILIATION

Low vision rehabilitation services provide one-on-one instruction to individuals who are blind or visually impaired on how to use tools such as optical aids, computer technology, video magnification, and electronic readers.



Specialized instruction can include, but is not limited to the following:

- Assessing general eyewear
- Light and glare control
- Optical aids such as magnifiers and telescopes
- Magnification systems such as CCTV or portable hand held magnifiers
- Visual field rehabilitation
- Functional vision assessments
- Access computer technology such as Zoom Text, JAWS, and Window-Eyes

Each individual's history, functional assessment of vision, skills, and evaluation of low vision aids will determine the low vision rehab plan.

*Referrals may be made to other agencies to provide some of the services listed above.

EMPLOYMENT

We offer a facility-based employment program for people who are blind. A variety of production and service jobs are available to our blind Associates. We provide a comfortable environment in our modern Industry designed to maximize self worth and positive self esteem.
