From Waynesboro

1. Take 254 W.
2. Turn right at Long Meadow Road / Route 608. Go 0.7 miles.
3. Turn right onto Madrid Road / Route 785. Go 0.9 miles.
4. Farm is on the right - approx. 1 mile. (Gatehouse marks entrance)

From I-64, Exit 91

1. Take Route 608 (towards hospital)
2. Follow to intersection with Route 250 (Jefferson Hwy)
3. Make a left at the light (Route 250)
4. Make a right at next traffic light (still 608 / Long Meadow Rd)
5. Follow 608 to stop sign of Route 254 intersection (8 miles). Go straight & continue on for approx. 1 mile
6. Turn right onto Madrid Road.
7. Farm is on the right - approx. 1 mile. (Gatehouse marks entrance)
