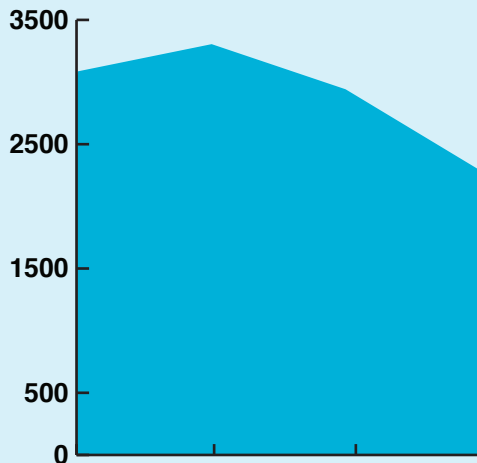

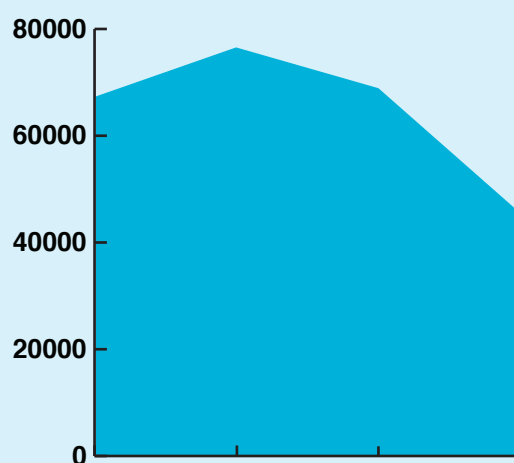

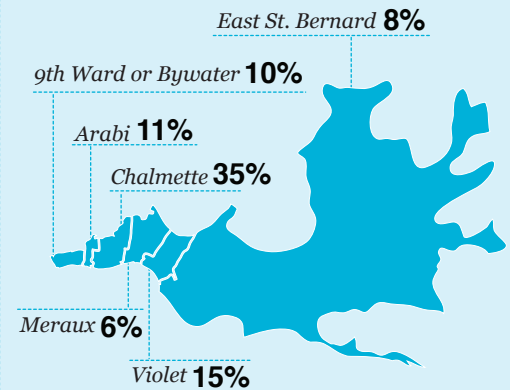

Clients by Zip Code

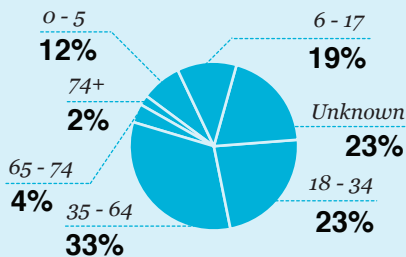


Clients by Parish

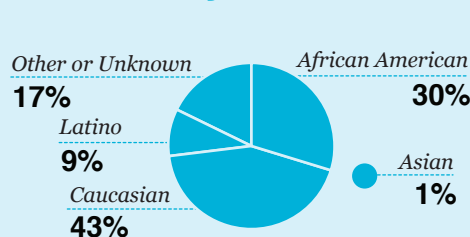

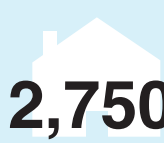

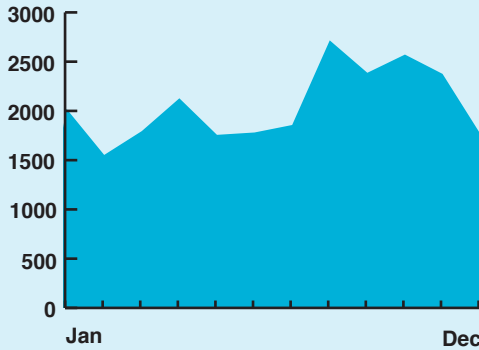

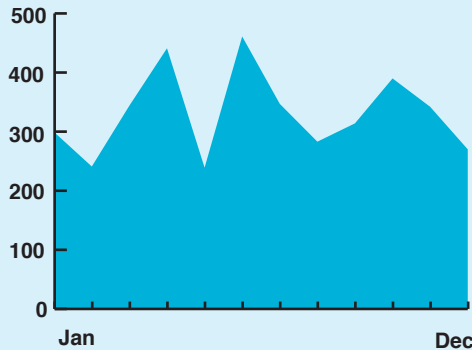

Clothing Distro Sign-ins per Month

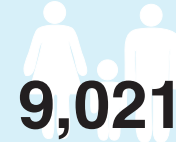


Books Given per Month



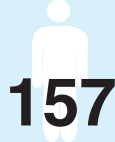

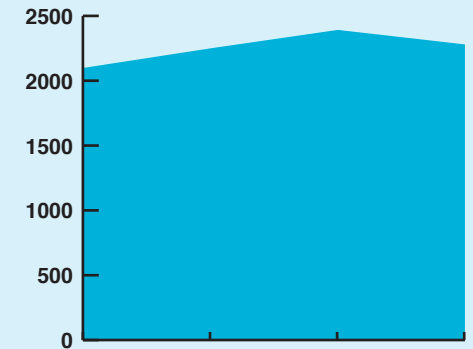

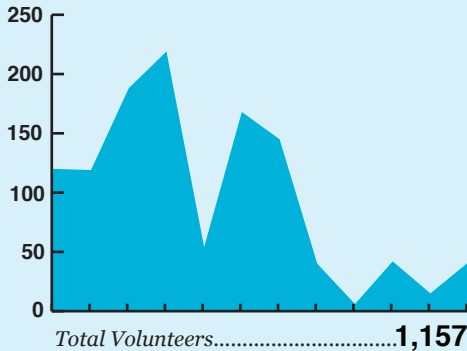

Media Lab Sign-ins per Quarter



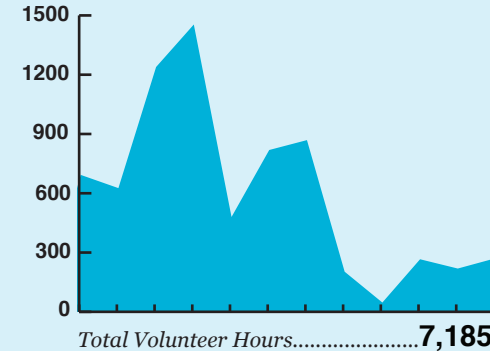

Volunteers per Month



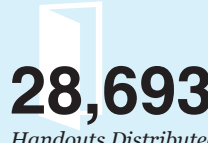

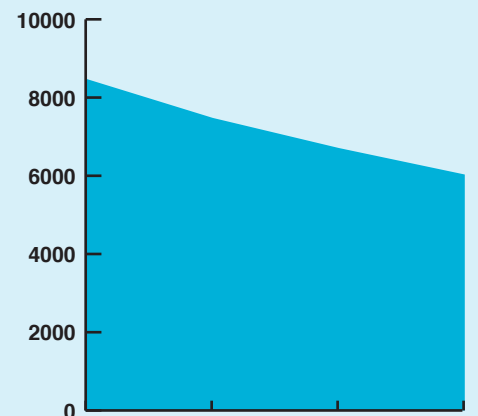

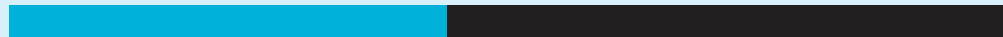


Partner Agency Data
